The Walkathon

This year we are holding the 18th Walkathon. It is a sponsored walk in aid of the Guide-dog school in Biot (l'Ecole Méditerranéenne de Chiens Guides d'Aveugles) and it involves students from the CIV, Niki de St Phalle and L'Eganaude, the two primary schools – Trois Collines and Sartoux and the Wednesday English group.

The walk will take place on Saturday 14th April from 10h-14h. Registrations will be taken in front of the Agora at CIV. The circuit is 4km and can be walked as many times as possible. The departure is from the Agora, past Eganaude and back to the CIV. A circuit map will be available on the ASEICA site soon. Sponsorship forms can be downloaded from the site aseica.org

Each participant is asked to find sponsors (friends, family, neighbours, shopkeepers, etc.) who will agree to pay a small amount of money for each lap completed.

There will be a BBQ and refreshments such as cakes and quiches will be on sale in front of the Agora. (We would be very pleased if you would like to contribute a cake or quiche!)

Since 1991 the Walkathon has raised over 35,000 euros for the guide dogs. This money is well spent, paying for the education of dogs to help the blind. Some of these dogs and their trainers will be there for the event.

The cost of training a dog varies but it is normally between 15 - 20,000 euros. Last year we contributed the biggest part of training a dog named Alias, who is now living and working successfully with her mistress.

How you can help???

Firstly, you can encourage your child to take part in the Walkathon. Encourage him/her to find as many sponsors as possible.

Secondly, come along on the morning of the 4th February and bring all the family, your friends and dogs (on leads please) and join in the walk.

Thirdly, we need volunteers to help with the preparation. We need parents on the day to assist with the setting up, to be supervisors on the circuit, to assist with registration and the cleaning up afterwards. We are also looking for someone trained in first aid and an accountant to help with the collection of money.

Fourthly, we would like you to bake some cakes or quiches which can be sold on the day.

And most importantly we need you to sponsor your children and their friends.
